geographic reassignment that prevents the military member student from attending class and completing coursework as planned. Geographic reassignment must be demonstrated by orders clearly stating that the student is physically relocating during the term in question.

Section 4. IMPLEMENTATION RESPONSIBILITY

- 4.1 In the event of an unexpected call to duty, the military member student shall be afforded a choice of options for completion of enrolled coursework.
 - 4.1.1 If the military member student has completed 75 percent or more of

- 4.1.1.a Receive full credit for the course, with assignment of the grade earned up to the time of the call to duty, or
- 4.1.1.b Withdraw from the course without academic penalty and receive no credit for the course pursued.
